JUMPER RULES & RENTAL AGREEMENT

SPECIFIC RULES TO FOLLOW:

1. Compatible age groups must play on unit at the same time. Age groups must not be mixed. Different sized children must not be mixed. 2. The Party jump is designed for children and is not recommended to be used by adults.
2. The maximum number of children allowed in the Party Jump (15x15)
 - Ages 2 to 8 years old (8 children)
 - Ages 9 to 13 years old (6 children)
 - Ages 14 to 17 years old (4 children)
3. All persons must remove shoes, glasses, jewelry, and anything else that may harm the Party Jump.
4. No flips or somersaults.
5. No food or drinks inside or near (within 10 feet) of the Party Jump!
6. Please do not cut plastic ties on front of the Party Jump.
7. Please do not tape or fasten anything to the Party Jump.
8. ABSOLUTLY NO SILLY STRING!! If silly string or any similar substance is permitted to come in contact with the inside or outside of the inflatable unit, a \$200.00 cleaning fee shall be automatically imposed by TJ's Party Jumpers. If, in our opinion, the damage is severe enough to render the unit un-rentable, the customer will be responsible for the replacement of the unit (minimum \$1,500), at full replacement price, and any loss of revenue until the replacement arrives. The reason for this policy is that the chemicals in these products cause irreparable damage to the inflatable and the cleaners that have to be used to remove them also cause additional damage.
9. In The event of rain or high winds, evacuate the inflatable and unplug immediately.
10. Children must be supervised at all times. Please read list of rules to all children using Party Jump.
11. KIMU Concessions reserves the right to cancel the delivery of any of our rental equipment when we believe weather conditions are unsafe for its use. If we believe conditions are safe, but rain is present or is forecast, we will leave it up to the customer. Once you leave with it there will be no refunds due to inclement weather.

SHOULD THE PARTY JUMP BEGIN TO DEFLATE:

1. The motor has stopped - check the cord connection at the outlet and at the motor.
Remember use of more than one (1) extension cord can trip the circuit breaker.
2. The motor continues to run -check the air intake on the side of the motor for blockage.
Check both tubes on back of Party Jump for snugness; and retie if necessary.
3. Any problems or questions with equipment please call Kimberly at 918-851-7032. I agree to accept for use as is, the Party Jump unit listed on this form and to accept full responsibility for the care of all equipment while it is in my possession. I agree to pay full retail value of any equipment rented under this agreement that I do not return. I agree to pay extra rental fees for any equipment returned late. I agree to return all rental equipment by the agreed upon time and date in a clean condition to avoid any additional charge. I agree to follow all rules stated on this agreement.
